Simply Homeschool Science and Surf Camp Terms and Conditions

16 March 2021

The following terms and conditions (**"Terms and Conditions**") apply to the sale of tickets (**"Tickets**") by **Simply Homeschool Pty Ltd** (**"Simply Homeschool" ABN 46 642 504 943**) to the Simply Homeschool Science and Surf Camp ("the **Camp**") held at NRMA Treasure Island Holiday Resort (**"the Venue"**). By purchasing, having someone else purchase or being gifted a Ticket to the Camp or otherwise attending the Camp you agree to be bound by and follow the Terms and Conditions. Simply Homeschool reserves its right to vary the Terms and Conditions at any time and will contact attendees with such changes personally.

Refunds, Changes and Cancellations and Payment

- 1. Where cancellations are received in writing to Simply Homeschool on or before 5:00pm (EST) Monday 26 April 2021 fees will be refunded less an AUD \$100 administrative charge.
- 2. Where cancellations are received after 5:00pm (EST) Monday 26 April 2021 fees will not be refunded, however, transfer of your registration to another person is acceptable provided they are a Full or Trial Member of Simply Homeschool.
- 3. Covid related Cancellations received in writing to Simply Homeschool before 5:00 pm (EST) Monday 10 May 2021 will be accepted and all fees refunded due to travel restrictions imposed by state or commonwealth governments impacting your ability to travel to the camp This includes those who are:
 - Restricted from travelling due to health and/or Government advice relating to COVID-19
 - Under Government direction to self-isolate
 - Awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test
 - Themselves, or have a family member, sick with COVID-19
 - Identified as close or casual contacts of a person who has a reported or suspected case of COVID-19 in the past 14 days
 - Have had flu-like symptoms in the last 72 hours
- 4. No refunds will be made for non-attendance at the Camp.
- 5. Simply Homeschool may cancel the Camp, for a reason outside their reasonable control, including without limitation, fire, poor weather conditions, drought, acts of God, rulings by council, the police or other authorities (a "Force Majeure Event"). Where the Camp is cancelled due to a Force Majeure Event, Simply Homeschool may provide refunds at its absolute discretion.
- 6. If you choose to pay in instalments Simply Homeschool will debit equal payments from the nominated credit card at the time of registration and on 26 March 2021, 9 April 2021 and 30 April 2021 depending on when purchase occurs. If the payment cannot be processed you will be contacted in regards to arranging an alternate payment method. Full payment must be made by a minimum of 10 days prior to the camp. If payment is not finalised by this date Simply Homeschool reserves the right to refuse entry to the Camp.
- 7. The amount of instalment payment will vary depending on the commencement date. As the full price must be paid by 30 April 2021, the earlier you purchase your ticket under the pay by instalment option, the less the amount of each instalment.
- 8. By opting to use the pay by instalment option to purchase your Ticket you authorise Simply Homeschool to arrange a transfer of funds from your nominated credit card in specified amounts and intervals.

Minors

1. This is a family and all ages event. A parent or legal guardian ("**Guardians**") must accompany at all times any person under the age of 18 (a "**Minor**") who attends the Camp. If you bring a Minor, you are responsible for ensuring they follow the Terms and Conditions.

Intellectual Property

Privacy

- In order for the camp to run it is necessary for campers to provide personal information, including personal information about minors. Simply Homeschool takes privacy seriously. We will at all times collect, store, use and disclose your personal information in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth), the Australian Privacy Principles and our Privacy Policy. You consent to be photographed and/or have visual images taken of you (or any Minors under your care) during activities, for use in Simply Homeschool publications, on the Simply Homeschool website, Facebook page, Instagram or for publicity purposes without acknowledgement and without being entitled to any remuneration or compensation. You understand that photographs/videos will not be used for biometric matching or identification. Simply Homeschool will not identify your name (or that of any Minors under your care) (or other details) in its use of any photographs/videos at any time. You will notify Simply Homeschool if you do not authorise them to take suitable photographs/videos of yourself or your child.

Waiver

1. I understand that to attend the camp I must fill out and sign any Waivers for third party activities from Xtreme Stem, Get Wet Surf School and other facilitators. These will be provided to you.

Indemnity

- 2. Simply Homeschool reserves the right to refuse entry to the Camp to any attendee or Minor should they behave in an unacceptable manner (e.g. bullying, violence or abuse of any form).
