

About Take 3

Take 3 are Australian leaders in removing plastic pollution and waste from the environment. Take 3's message is simple: Take 3 pieces of rubbish with you when you leave the beach, waterway or... anywhere. Through education that inspires participation, Take 3 are making tangible improvements to the health of our planet.

8 million tonnes of plastic enters the ocean every year. Plastic does not belong in the ocean. Plastic poses serious health threats to marine life through ingestion and entanglement. The Take 3 movement reduces plastic pollution by 10 million pieces every year.



Youth Summit

The Youth Summit will be held 7 - 8 June, 2021 at the Taronga Zoo Institute of Science and Learning. Over two action-packed days, 200 student leaders from 50 schools around NSW will assemble to learn from industry experts and youth leaders. Students will walk away with Community Action Projects developed at the summit workshops to engage their school communities in plastic pollution education and reduction. The projected outcomes are:

16,000 student lives impacted 55 community action projects

165,000 pieces of plastic removed

Opportunity to Attend

4 STUDENTS - 1 TEACHER - 2 DAYS OF LEARNING

Take 3 is excited to share an opportunity with your school to apply to attend the Take 3 Youth Summit 2021. 4 students - 1 teacher - 2 days of leadership education.

YOUTH SUMMIT DETAILS

Event Date: 7-8 JUNE 2021 Time: 8.30 am - 3.30 pm

Location: Taronga Institute of Science and Learning, Taronga Zoo

Costs: This event is FREE for 4 students and 1 teacher/quardian from an eligible school.

Please note - costs NOT covered by Take 3:

- 1. The cost of transportation to and from the Summit is not covered by Take 3 schools are responsible for getting students to and from the summit.
- 2. Lunch and morning tea is not provided by Take 3 students are required to bring their own morning tea and lunch packs.
- 3. Sleepover/additional meals. We advise, particularly regional schools, to book in to Zoo Sleepover if your school is one of the winners your fees will be waived.

YOUTH SUMMIT ZOO SLEEPOVER - ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITY - SELECT NUMBER OF SCHOOLS

Take 3 will select a small number of schools that are successful in their application for the Youth Summit (4 students - 1 teacher per school) to attend the Youth Summit Zoo Sleepover.

What to expect at the Youth Summit Zoo Sleepover: This unique overnight experience offers school students an opportunity to learn about animals, the environment and what we can all do to help make a difference for wildlife. Students will enjoy an exclusive night safari led by professional guides where they will get up and close with some of the zoo's friendliest residents including the Sumatran Tiger, Red Panda and Sea Lion pups. Students will also meet the keepers of Taronga and learn about the important role they play in caring for the animals. To be selected for the Youth Summit Zoo Sleepover teachers will have to apply by following the instructions below. Schools will be selected based on any prior work, commitments and projects they have engaged in to solve the problem of Plastic Pollution. The decision will be based on merit and decided upon by a panel of judges.



Selection Process & Eligibility Criteria

The Take 3 Youth Summit is a free event open to 200 students. Due to space limitations Take 3 will select students to attend based on the student meeting the below eligibility criteria and the quality of their application. Students and schools are required to provide Take 3 with reasoning why they would like to attend the summit and supply evidence where required. The applications will be reviewed by a selection panel and notified via email if their application is successful.

TAKE 3 YOUTH SUMMIT ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Have undergone a Take 3 program, outreach, activity or initiative
- Year 7 12
- Provide a statement about why the student would like to be selected to attend the Take 3 Youth Summit (up to 150 words). Think about the values of Take 3 and how you relate to them.

TAKE 3 YOUTH SUMMIT ZOO SLEEPOVER ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA - BE REWARDED FOR YOUR PROJECTS!

Schools will be selected based on any prior work, commitments and projects they have engaged in to solve the problem of Plastic Pollution. The decision will be based on merit and decided upon by a panel of judges.

- School has undergone a Take 3 program, outreach, activity or initiative
- Submit a statement of your understanding of plastic pollution and it's effect on the environment (up to 150 words).
- Provide additional evidence of the project, initiative or program you have initiated to raise awareness, educate or solve the problem of plastic pollution in your school or broader community.

Examples of evidence that will be considered: Posters, PowerPoint presentations, photos, videos, articles, media clippings, website links, project plans, letter of support, references. How To Register

1. FILL IN THE APPLICATION

Register - Complete the application form for all 4 students and 1 teacher at https://forms.gle/uswLP7i1HDY3spVT7. Read through the eligibility criteria and get all of your information together before you start the application. You can only submit the form once.

2. SUBMIT EVIDENCE

If you would like to apply to be among the lucky few schools selected for the Take 3 Youth Summit Zoo Sleepover, evidence must be submitted via email.
