


TEACHING NOTES

Try drawing animal tracks in sand or dirt.


Game - Same and Different

- 3. Select one more card each round. Explain why the card belongs in your set.


Game - Move like the animals



TEACHING NOTES


- 1. Discuss the colours you can see on each fish.
- 2. Find the matching pair of circles on the right.
- 3. Select two markers to match the circles/fish colours.
- 4. Join with two coloured lines to match each colour.



Cross the Midline: Top Down

TEACHING NOTES

Talk the rhyme - every time!

IN THE AIR:

Draw from the top right, then top middle, then top left.

Draw with Right Hand, Left Hand, then Both Hands together.

Repeat from the TOP LEFT, and then in the centre.

Draw one on a vertical whiteboard with eyes closed.



Trace the clouds.

Drip-drop the rainy lines downwards. Top to bottom and stop at the dot.

Colour the ant and her leaf umbrella.

















Pattern: Cut and Repeat
